- 2007 Wisconsin Act 1 merged the State Elections Board and Ethics Board
- Board consists of six former judges

 Nominated by Candidate Committee (composed of one Court of Appeals judge from each district chosen at random)
- Governor appointed and Legislature confirmed for staggered six-year terms


Board Member Requirements

- Cannot be a member of a political party
- Cannot be candidate
- Cannot have made a contribution for 12 months before serving
- Cannot make a contribution while serving
- Cannot hold another office
- Cannot be a lobbyist





Board Staff Requirements

- Cannot be a member of a political party or participate in partisan political activity
- Cannot be candidate
- Cannot have made a contribution for 12 months before serving
- Cannot make a contribution while serving
- Cannot hold another office
- Cannot be a lobbyist
- Cannot circulate or sign nomination papers of county non-partisan candidates

Elections Division

- Oversees administration of elections
- Trains and supports 1852 municipal clerks and 72 county clerks
- Ensures compliance with state and federal election laws
- Determines ballot eligibility for state and federal candidates
- Certifies election results for state and federal candidates
- Approves election equipment

Elections Division

- Hosts and maintains Statewide Voter Registration System (SVRS) & the MyVote Wisconsin website
 - Provides information to create poll lists, candidate lists, polling place locations, and reports for clerks and the public
 - Allows voters to check registration status, ballot and polling place information online military and permanent overseas voters to request an absentee ballot
 - Allows military and permanent overseas voters to request an absentee ballot and access their absentee ballot online

Election Landscape

By the Numbers

- → Wisconsin population: 5.7 million
- SVRS: 4.4 million voters,∼ 3.4 million currently eligibleand registered voters
- 2010 General Election 2.19 million voters
- 2012 General Election 3.08 million voters
- 1852 municipal clerks, and 72 county clerks
- □ 35,000 poll workers at 2800 polling places
- Wisconsin has 2% of US population,
 but 4% of its election officials





Election Administration Topics



Accessibility Audit Program

- Only State to conduct accessibility audits of actual polling set-up on Election Day
 - Parking and pathways
 - Entrances and interior routes
 - Elevators
 - Voting Area

Use of technology to improve process




Accessibility Audit Program

- Almost 2,000 audits completed in 1135 municipalities and 66 counties
- Audit reports generated and sent to municipal and county clerks
- Assistance with ideas for fixes
- Compilation of common problems and best practices
- Cited by Presidential Commission as a model for other states

Badger, Voters

- Website to request and obtain voter data from SVRS
- Purchased by candidates, parties and other organizations, researchers
- Mandatory charge under statute and administrative rules
- Automated process to:
 - Request one of six standard reports
 - Receive price quote
 - Make purchase of data
 - Download data



Badger, Voters

- Available 24/7
- Confidential data is protected
- Staff savings of 0.5 FTE
- Reduces process time from about 5 days to about 15 minutes for almost all requests

Observer Rules

- Any member of the public, excluding a candidate, has the right to be present at a polling place to observe the public aspects of voting

 §7.41, Wis. Stats.
- Observer area now 3-8 feet from polling tables
